



## Shared Heritage Values

The region has a rich history of pastoral, agricultural and mining industries, and a number of shared heritage sites have been identified within Local Government areas contained within the Project's study area. The majority of listed shared heritage sites in the study area are found in the major towns, distant from any planned construction activities. These include:

- Public buildings
- Memorials
- Houses
- Churches
- Cemeteries

Project facilities will be designed and located to minimise the potential impact on identified culturally significant areas listed under the *Queensland Heritage Act, 1992*.

## Indigenous Heritage Values

APLNG will manage the impact of the Project on Aboriginal cultural heritage within the framework of the *Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Act, 2003*. Cultural heritage assessments will be undertaken with relevant Aboriginal Parties. The Project area encompasses a landscape that holds widespread traces of prior Aboriginal use. These include known sites such as:

- Scarred trees
- Scatters of stone artefacts
- Shell middens

Procedures will be put in place to identify, record and assess heritage items uncovered during construction, so that appropriate management of these items and sites can occur.
