

# The Australia Pacific LNG Project



Australia Pacific LNG (APLNG) is proposing a coal seam gas (CSG) to liquefied natural gas (LNG) project in Queensland.

We have Queensland's largest undeveloped CSG reserves and this Project will enable the creation of a world scale, long-term industry using those resources.

The Project consists of:

- The further development of APLNG's coal seam gas fields in the Surat and Bowen basins

- The construction of a gas transmission pipeline approximately 400 kilometres long from the coal seam gas fields to a LNG plant at Gladstone
- Development of the LNG plant which will have a processing capacity of up to 16 million tonnes per annum (Mtpa)
